

FULL NOTICE OF INTENT TO  
ADOPT ETHICS COMMISSION RULES

TAKE NOTICE that the North Dakota Ethics Commission will hold a public hearing to address proposed Ethics Commission Rules at 9:00 a.m. CT on Nov 30, 2021, at 101 Slate Dr. Suite #4, in Bismarck. The purpose of the proposed rule is to establish conflict of interest rules for public officials, boards and commissions. These rules will provide a uniform process for disclosing and addressing conflicts of interest. The proposed rules will have no fiscal impact and are not expected to have an impact on the regulated community in excess of \$50,000. These are not emergency rules.
