

August 15, 2023: Ethics Commission Hires General Counsel

Attorney Logan Carpenter will begin serving as General Counsel with the North Dakota Ethics Commission in September 2023.

Mr. Carpenter received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science, *magna cum laude*, from the University of Jamestown in 2017. While at the University of Jamestown, Logan played alto saxophone in the concert and jazz bands, worked as a teaching assistant, and was selected as a College Fellow in Political Science. Following his undergraduate studies, Logan attended law school at the University of North Dakota School of Law where he graduated *magna cum laude* in 2020.
