- 1. <u>Call to Order:</u> The legislative hearing of the Senate State and Local Government Committee on Senate Bill 2048 was called to order by the Chair, Senator Kristen Roers, at 9:02 a.m. The following members representing a quorum of the Ethics Commission were also present: Chair Paul Richard, Vice Chair David Anderson, Commissioner Cynthia Lindquist, Executive Director Rebecca Binstock, and Office Manager Holly Gaugler.
- 2. <u>SB 2048 Hearing:</u> SB 2048 amends N.D.C.C. Chapter 54-66 and includes three sections. These amendments equitably expand the classes of individuals who can file a complaint, promote consistent application of the Ethics Commission's jurisdiction, and revise the process of notifying an individual accused of an alleged ethics violation.
