- While we encourage your participation, please keep your comments on topic. The Commission regularly reviews comments and reserves the right to remove any comments it determines, within its sole discretion, are unrelated to the Commission's work or the subject matter being commented on, and/or:
 - vulgar;
 - abusive;
 - threatening;
 - harassing;
 - profane;
 - obscene;
 - spam;
 - duplicate comments;
 - solely promoting or advertising a business or commercial transaction;
 - contain sexual content, nudity, or links to such content;
 - encourage or constitute illegal activity; or
 - campaign for or against the nomination or election of a candidate, or the qualification, passage, or defeat of a ballot question.
- Comments that promote, foster, or perpetuate discrimination on the basis of race, creed, color, age, religion, gender, marital status, status with regard to public assistance, national origin, physical or mental disability, or sexual orientation are prohibited.
